REALLOCATION OF DROUGHT COMMUNITIES PROGRAMME FUNDING

Balonne Shire Council consent is sought to apply to the Federal Department of Infrastructure and Regional Development to reallocate \$20,000 in funding to repaint the St George Cultural Centre façade to the St George River Foreshore. This is due to the Cultural Centre being earmarked for redevelopment in future projects.

That Council agree to apply to the Federal Department of Infrastructure and Regional Development to relocate \$20,000 funding for the St George Cultural Centre façade repainting to the St George River Foreshore canoe ramp and carpark redevelopment.

Lot A on SP126288 is adjacent to a stock route. Accordingly, the landholder must NOT at any time impact the operations or utilise the stock route without consent of Council's Rural Services.

The purpose of this report is for Council to consider a siting variation for a residential shed located at 9 Carnation Avenue, St George being Lot 5 RP93081.

- Council approve the proposed siting variation, allowing the residential outbuilding to be setback a minimum distance of 3.2 metres from the southern rear boundary of the property at 9 Carnation Avenue, St George.
- 3. Council state to the applicant/owner of the property that the shed does not have building works approval. Accordingly, retrospective approval must be applied for and obtained either through Balonne Shire Council or Private Certification.
